INDICATORS FOR MEASURING THE RESULTS OF THE STANDARD

The production of a report or evaluation is a common requirement of the Conseil du trésor for the renewal of a program. To carry out this task, the Ministry will need to gather information from applicants and beneficiaries of the current program prior to finalizing their agreement with the Ministry, as well as during the implementation period of that agreement. This collection of information will enable the Ministry to report on the program's outcomes through the following indicators:

- the number of actions taken, categorized by the sectors involved in an Indigenous cultural partnership;
- the number of sectors covered by an Indigenous cultural partnership;
- the number of human resources dedicated exclusively to Indigenous culture or languages and funded by an Indigenous cultural partnership;
- the total cost of the actions undertaken;
- the percentage of the Indigenous population impacted by an Indigenous cultural partnership.

The information requested by the Ministry regarding each action taken will allow for categorization based on type, the intervention sector it falls under, the target population, and whether it is linked to a specific measure of a government action plan or strategy. These distinctions will enable the Ministry to identify the effects of the program to which they contribute and to indirectly quantify those effects.

Given the nature of this program and the type of relationship the Government of Québec maintains with Indigenous nations, communities, and organizations, the program's results will be supplemented by cultural statistics to which the Ministry already has access, in addition to its internal data. This provision aims to reduce the administrative burden of the program.

If deemed relevant, the Ministry may also consult beneficiaries for a one-time collection of information at the time the report required for the program's renewal is produced.
