Aim of the Pathway

The College Challenge (080.08) pathway offers a flexible approach allowing educational institutions to offer adapted training to their future students with prior learning in secondary education by giving them the opportunity to pursue college-level courses while completing their secondary school studies leading to a Secondary School Diploma (SSD).

Admission Requirements

There are no admission requirements.

However, the student must have obtained the Secondary V credits in the subject of the pursued course and must be studying full-time toward obtaining the SSD.

Attendance Specifications

Students must be enrolled in the College Challenge pathway on a part-time basis, for the fall, winter or summer semesters.

A person may be registered for the College Challenge pathway for no more than two consecutive terms.

Except in cases specifically authorized by college authorities, the maximum duration of two consecutive terms in the pathway cannot be extended. In situations where exceptions are granted, the college must keep a record in the student's file.

Training Offer Within the Pathway

As part of the College Challenge pathway, the college offers students one or more courses adapted to their needs, while also taking into account any constraints with respect to their studies leading to the SSD. The courses on offer as part of the College Challenge pathway must fall under one of these categories:

- Courses related to the [general education](#) objectives of the programs leading to the Diploma of College Studies (DCS)
- Courses related to the [program-specific](#) (document in French only) objectives of the programs leading to the DCS
