- when the reasons justifying the application no longer exist.

Information Concerning the Application for Revocation of Striking Off Filed by a Third Party

The Demande de révocation de radiation présentée par un tiers (application for revocation of striking off filed by a third party) form (RE-701) is intended for any interested third party who wishes to apply to revoke the striking off of an enterprise's registration.

Please complete the form onscreen or using a typewriter so that it is legible and suitable for reproduction.

Note: If you need more space to enter the required information, you can attach one or more extra sheets to the form. Enter the enterprise's name and Québec enterprise number (NEQ) (if applicable), the form title and section number at the top of each sheet.

The term "enterprise" used below refers to a natural person operating a sole proprietorship, a partnership, an association or a group of persons, a commercial trust or a legal person.

The application may be submitted by an interested third party only if the enterprise's registration has been struck off ex officio due to failure to file one or more annual updating declarations or failure by the enterprise to comply with any other obligation that the Registraire des entreprises (hereinafter referred to as the "Registraire") requires the enterprise to comply with under the *Act respecting the legal publicity of enterprises* (hereinafter referred to as the "ALPE").

Anyone who knowingly makes a false, incomplete or misleading statement is committing an offense and is liable to a fine ranging from \$500 to \$5,000 in the case of a natural person and from \$1,000 to \$10,000 in all other cases.

For more information on the legislative provisions governing the filing of the application, refer to the ALPE.

Protection of personal information

Some of the information you must provide on this form is personal information. The only people with access to personal information are those who are authorized to view it as part of their duties.

You have the right to know what kind of personal information the Ministère de l'Emploi et de la Solidarité sociale has about you, to receive that information and to request its correction. To do so, contact the person in charge of access to documents and the protection of personal information.

Revocation of striking off

The Registraire will revoke the ex officio striking off of the enterprise's registration by depositing a notice to that effect in the enterprise register (hereinafter referred to as the "register"). A copy of the notice will be sent to the enterprise, and the applicant will be informed of the revocation by mail.

Revocation of the striking off of the registration of a legal person constituted in Québec causes the legal person to resume existence on the date of the notice's deposit. The registration of the enterprise is deemed never to have been struck off, and the legal person constituted in Québec is deemed never to have been dissolved.

Requirements for ex officio striking off

Since an application filed by a third person does not have to be accompanied by the updating declarations, the initial declaration, notices or fees required under the ALPE that caused the enterprise's registration to be struck off ex officio, the striking off will be revoked for 12 months after the application for revocation of striking off is filed. After this period, the enterprise's registration can be struck off ex officio again by the Registraire.

For this reason, every year, the applicant must inform the Registraire in writing, in accordance with the requirements stipulated in the application, that the enterprise's registration is not to be struck off ex officio again.

If legal proceedings are instituted against the enterprise, the applicant must inform the Registraire when the proceedings are finished. If the applicant fails to comply with these requirements, the enterprise's registration could be struck off ex officio without prior notice.

Contact person and priority service

Enter the contact information of the person responsible for the application (last name, first name, telephone number, mailing address and email address). If you are requesting priority service, check the box and write "**Traitement prioritaire**" on the envelope.

The information provided will be used solely for the purposes of the application and will not be entered in the enterprise register. If you are an authorized intermediary, enter your NEQ in the space provided.

Fees and terms of payment

The application must include payment of the fees required under the ALPE. For the applicable fees, check the list of all fees and tariffs of the Registraire des entreprises, available at Quebec.ca.

The application for revocation of striking off filed by a third person as well as the applicant's sworn declaration and other documents required under the ALPE must be sent by mail to the following address:
