This document sets out the position of the criminal and penal prosecuting attorney concerning the conclusions sought for the case, on the condition that the accused meets all the objective of the intervention plan under the Programme d'accompagnement justice et santé mentale+ (PAJ-SM+). This key document results from discussions under the PAJ-SM+ and must not be disclosed to any person outside the Program without the consent of the prosecuting attorney and the accused. In cases of offenses for which a minimum sentence is provided, only the trajectory provided for in section 720 of the Criminal Code can be followed, which implies a conviction.

The position on the outcome of the case is:

- provided with the objective of helping the accused decide whether or not to participate in the PAJ-SM+;
- based on the information available to the prosecuting attorney at that date; and
- subject to change based on new information, further evidence or negotiations with the accused's lawyer concerning the terms and conditions set out in the document.

The position document on the outcome of the case may be withdrawn, at the prosecuting attorney's discretion, if:

- the accused commits other offences or breaches court-ordered conditions;
- new information or further evidence is forwarded by the prosecuting attorney; or
- the accused fails the Program.

The position document on the outcome of the case is made under:

Section 717 of the *Criminal Code* and will lead to the dismissal of the indictment(s) concerning the counts for the following proceedings:

If section 717 of the *Criminal Code* applies, the prosecution may request a recognizance under:

Section 810 of the *Criminal Code* leading to a surety to keep the peace for indictment(s) concerning the following counts:

Section 720 of the *Criminal Code* requires the entering of a plea of guilty for the following counts:

If section 720 of the *Criminal Code* applies, the prosecution will present this sentencing position as part of a joint submission to the court. The judge will decide the sentence.
