TRADE RELATIONS

- Bilateral trade reached US\$2.6 billion in 2023.
- Québec is the 2nd trade partner of Georgia among Canadian provinces.

INVESTING IN GEORGIA

- From 2014 to 2023, Canada ranked 4th globally for FDI in Georgia.
 - › Québec secured the 1st spot among Canadian provinces.
- Québec companies invested more in Georgia than larger economies like Brazil and Mexico.
- These investments went to key sectors, such as energy, aerospace and life sciences, enhancing the state's technological innovation and global competitiveness.

CREATING AND MAINTAINING JOBS

- There are more than 50 Georgia-based companies operating in Québec—any trade barrier could directly impact their success and growth.
- Around 45 Québec-owned companies operate across the Peach state, creating several hundred jobs which contribute to Georgia's economy.



AEROSPACE

- In 2023, Québec fueled Georgia's aerospace industry:
 - » **No. 1** international supplier of flight simulators;
 - » **No. 2** for turbojets;
 - » **No. 8** for aircraft parts.
- Québec is the 3rd largest aerospace hub in the world and is integrated with the North American ecosystem.
- Our companies stimulate innovation, support the development of a skilled workforce and strengthen the competitiveness of the sector against foreign competitors.

ALUMINUM AND OTHER METALS

- In 2023, Québec was a major supplier of aluminum and other metals products to the U.S. In Georgia, Québec stood out as the 1st supplier of zinc alloy and 2nd of unwrought aluminum.
- Québec accounts for more than 50% of U.S. imports of primary aluminum for manufacturing in the U.S.
- These components power Georgia's strategic industries, including the automotive sector.
 - » Québec is notably the 2nd importer of Georgia bus manufacturers and ranks 3rd for trailers and tires.

FORESTRY PRODUCTS

- In 2023, Québec was the 4th largest supplier of forestry products of Georgia.
- We're Georgia's 1st international supplier of particle board, 2nd of softwood lumber and 4th for joinery and carpentry products – essential materials for the construction sector.
- Tariffs on lumber and other building materials will drive up construction costs, hinder new development, and burden consumers with higher home prices.
- Québec's high-quality materials can be used to build a stronger, more affordable Georgia.

FACTS

- **A trusted economic partner:** Our close collaboration can strengthen and secure an integrated North American economy.
- **A rich and diverse subsoil:** Québec has the most diverse reservoir of critical and mineral resources in Canada and a world-class deposit of rare earth minerals. Québec has 15 of the 18 (83%) of the critical minerals listed for energy by the Department of Energy, and 41 of 50 (82%) of the USGS's minerals list that are considered critical for the U.S. economy and national security.
- **An innovation hub:** Québec has a leading-edge expertise in emerging technologies, such as AI and quantum computing.
