- 3. a true copy certified by a commissioner for oaths of the final certificate of a will search by the Chambre des notaires du Québec:
- 4. a true copy certified by a commissioner for oaths of the certificate of a will search by the Barreau du Québec;
- 5. **a true copy certified by a commissioner for oaths** of the notarized will, where applicable; **or** the probate decision, in the case of a holographic (handwritten) will, **or** your birth certificate or declaration of heredity, if there is no will.

Instructions

General instructions

This form, the use of which is optional, is provided to those who wish to make an access request to the Curateur public du Québec.

Note that the information you provide in the "General information about the applicant" section is confidential and will only be shared with individuals authorized to process your request.

Request for access to documents containing personal information

A request for access to personal information must be made in writing and addressed to the person in charge of access. Pursuant to the *Act respecting access to documents held by public bodies and the protection of personal information*, a

request for personal information concerns a person:

- · who is under private protective supervision;
- · who is the subject of an application to institute protective supervision;
- who is benefiting from provisional representation of the person or provisional administration of the property by an individual other than the Curateur public;
- who is the subject of an application to homologate a mandate in case of incapacity or for whom such a mandate has been homologated;
- · who is under supervision involving an advisor to the person of full age.

An applicant whose request to access information has been refused, in whole or in part, or who has not obtained a response to said request within the deadline prescribed by the Access Act may ask the Commission d'accès à l'information du Québec to review the decision of the Curateur public du Québec.

According to the *Public Curator Act*, a request for personal information concerns a person:

- · who is represented by the Curateur public in the capacity of tutor or curator;
- who is provisionally represented by the Curateur public to ensure the protection of his person, the exercise of his rights, or the administration of his property.

The *Public Curator Act* contains no provisions for an applicant's recourse to the Commission d'accès à l'information du Québec in the event his request is refused. However, an applicant whose request for access to information was refused pursuant to the *Public Curator Act* may file a complaint with the Curateur public du Québec's Bureau des plaintes or the office of the Québec Ombudsman. Finally, Article 41 of the *Civil Code of Quebec* stipulates that the applicant may apply to the Superior Court of Québec in the event there is a problem in exercising the right to consult or correct a file.
