Protection of Personal Information

If you do not provide the documents yourself when making your application, the Ministère informs you that it may contact:

- your educational institution to validate your student status and verify that you are eligible for a scholarship
- Revenu Québec and the Canada Revenue Agency, in accordance with the *Taxation Act* and the *Income Tax Act*
- the Ministère des Finances du Québec or the Centre d'acquisitions gouvernementales for payment of the scholarship amount

In addition, the Ministère informs you that it will use the information it already holds in order to verify whether you are eligible for a scholarship. Rest assured that this information will be accessible only to a limited number of people, that it will be used only for the purpose of administering and evaluating the program, and that it will be destroyed afterwards. The Ministère will also contact you using the personal information provided for the purpose of evaluating the program. You are not under any obligation to apply for the Québec Perspective Scholarship. The only consequence of not doing so is that you will not receive the financial assistance. Lastly, you have the right to access your personal information as well as request its correction under certain conditions.
