

EXPLANATORY NOTES

NOTICE OF CONTINUANCE OF SUIT (SJ-852-01A)

The “Notice of Continuance of Suit” form enables a person who has a legal interest to act (such as a tutor or liquidator) to appear for a party involved in a small claims application who has undergone a change of status subsequent to incapacity, a disability, death, the termination of his or her services, etc.

TYPE OF FORM

- Dynamic PDF:

After completing the form, you can print it on letter-sized paper, i.e. 8.5 inches by 11 inches (215.9 mm by 279.4 mm).

- Paper:

If you complete the form by hand, please write legibly in block letters.

Once the form is completed, you should keep a copy for your files.

FILING AT THE COURT OFFICE

You must submit the notice to the Small Claims Division office at the courthouse where the application was filed. To do this, you may use the Digital Court Office of Québec (GNJQ), which is accessible via the website of the Ministère de la Justice at www.justice.gouv.qc.ca.

The clerk will then send notice to the other parties, who will have 10 days to contest.
