

EXPLANATORY NOTES

APPLICATION FOR JUDGMENT AGAINST A GARNISHEE IN DEFAULT (SJ-857-13A)

The “Application for Judgment Against a Garnishee in Default” form is used to obtain a judgment where a garnishee fails to file a declaration, withhold or deposit a sum of money or made a false declaration. In such a case, the garnishee may be ordered to pay the amount owing as personal debtor.

TYPES OF FORMS

- Dynamic PDF:

After completing the form, you can print it on letter-sized paper, i.e. 8.5 inches by 11 inches (215.9 mm by 279.4 mm).

- Paper:

If you complete the form by hand, please write legibly in block letters.

PROCEDURE

After completing the form, keep a copy for your files.

You will need to contact the Small Claims Division office to obtain information to complete the “Notice of Presentation” section of the form.

FILING AT THE COURT OFFICE

You must then submit the form to the Small Claims Division office. To do this, you may use the Digital Court Office of Québec (GNJQ), which is accessible via the website of the Ministère de la Justice at www.justice.gouv.qc.ca.
