STATEMENT FOR JUDGMENT BY DEFAULT

(deemed to have been made under oath)
(SJ-986A)

The “Statement for judgment by default” form enables a plaintiff to ask the court to render a judgment by default against a defendant who fails to file a contestation within the specified time period.

TYPES OF FORMS

- Dynamic PDF:

After completing the form, you can print it on letter-sized paper, i.e. 8.5 inches by 11 inches (215.9 mm by 279.4 mm).

- Paper:

If you complete the form by hand, please write legibly in block letters.

Once the form is completed, you should keep a copy for your files.

FILING AT THE COURT OFFICE

You must then submit the statement to the Small Claims Division office. To do this, you may use the Digital Court Office of Québec (GNJQ), which is accessible via the website of the Ministère de la Justice at www.justice.gouv.qc.ca.
